Presidents Report

It has been a challenging year for all sports across Australia with the irregular interruptions of the Covid-19 pandemic. However despite all the associated difficulties nevertheless the Westfields Athletics Club (hereafter referred to as WAC) had one of its most successful seasons. The 2020/21 season was in fact our 30th as a club. I formed the club in 1991 with the permission of Athletics NSW and our first year's membership was a modest 25 registered athletes and administrators. As a school based club the highest our registration numbers have ever reached was 110 back in the early 2000's and in more recent years it has levelled out to between 70 and 80 in total each season.

One of the great advantages of having a school based club is the ability to tap into the school's population and provide a service to talented students who would often only compete in the school system and not register with a club. Westfields Sports being the second most populous school in NSW with almost 1800 students has allowed for this school based model to operate successfully. Furthermore having 70-80 athletes allows for a workable coach to athlete ratio which in turn provides a quality service. WAC is able to benefit from the facilities, equipment and staff provided by the school. We like to refer to this setup as the Westfields family where all Westfields students in the Talented Sports Programs are provided with access to Strength & Conditioning facilities and professional trainers, Sports Psychology, six professional athletics coaches employed by the school, and many other benefits.

WAC is fortunate to have many volunteers willing to help organise and run the necessary tasks required by a club. This would not be possible without the generous and selfless work of many parents, staff and other volunteers. Janet Stickler has been involved for a quarter of a century when her son Paul first became a member and has stayed and worked for WAC ever since, despite her son Paul retiring from the sport almost 20 years ago. Over the years she has been Vice President, Secretary, Registrar, Uniform coordinator and currently holds the position of honorary treasurer. She is a life member an asset without whom WAC could not properly function. Our six professional coaches were chosen over the years as the best available to work within our specialist environment and they bring with them a vast amount of experience. Denis Knowles, Christie Chamberlain, Leo Dulay, Shane Castlereagh, Brett Mathison, yours truly, and regular appearances as back up coaches with Sharyn Dickson and Hayden Kovacic form a wealth of support that is irreplaceable. Budget restrictions allowing, WAC intends to add Hayden Kovacic to a permanent coaching position. Special mention must go to Denis Knowles who as Dani Stevens coach is one of the leading discus coaches in the World and Brett Mathison just this season was voted NSW Club coach of the year. Mere words are not enough to thank our coaches for their invaluable contributions throughout the season.

Our generous sponsors, benefactors and supporters continue to provide WAC with the monetary contributions required to operate the club. Foremost is Club Liverpool who have provided assistance over the past 19 years. They graciously donate \$4000 each year and the cheque handed over on Presentation Night this year amounted to a total of \$76,000 they have contributed since 2003. Our dear Adhemar Ferreira da Silva Scholarship benefactors, Rosemary and Wilf Mula, founded the scholarship and 2021 was the

19th year of its presentation. The scholarship consisting of trophy, \$1000, an Interstate trip of the athletes choice (with coach) was this year won by Aleksandra Stoilova. The Adhemar Scholarship is valued at approximately \$2000 - \$3000 (depending on the athletes chosen competition destination and Rosemary and Wilf have contributed a total amount over the years approaching \$100,000. Steve Want owner of the Sportsfactory, has also been one of WAC's longest supporters providing monetary prizes and invaluable access to his line of quality uniforms produced here in Australia (not in China). During 2020 and 2021 WAC has also received generous donations from Cassilles Joinery (\$1000 each year) as well as donations from the following families: Stickler, Banovich, Nadya-Harb, Goetz, Alizart and Hunter. Photography has been a key part of support and many thanks goes to the continued efforts of Danielle Banovich and Winston Monzon for their voluntary efforts and many hours of watching our students perform through their camera lenses. Danielle Banovich in particular has been very helpful in the organisation of trips, particularly the acquisition of accommodation and meals for the overnight trip to the ACT Championships.

The largest single fundraising venture each year is the Annual Trivia Night organised by Sharyn Dickson. The logistics involved are unfathomable. Sharyn sends out 400 letters to local businesses pleading for prizes and vouchers to raffle off at the annual function. She compiles the questions, sets up the venue and essentially runs the whole show. She raises between \$4000- \$5000 each time and has over recent years raised over \$30,000. Unfortunately Covid-19 has affected the regularity of the function and postponements have occurred. Nevertheless Sharyn battles-on and reschedules the event accordingly. Particular thanks also goes to the St Johns Park Bowling Club for allowing us to use their main function room at no cost and providing outstanding staff and service. Long time supporters of Westfields Sports is Canley Height RSL and they have expressed an interest in providing their venue for next year's WAC functions.

Last but by no means least are the amazing achievements of our athletes. During the 2020/21 season they competed in a total of **448 individual events**. A complete report listing every performance is provided here after in this report however a few outstanding achievements can't go without mention. Dani Stevens competing at her 4th Olympic Games after a debilitating neck operation was inspirational to the point she was elected Women's Team Captain for Tokyo 2020. Asked at our Presentation function if she would continue after Tokyo she diplomatically hinted she will take each year as it comes. WAC had 3 World U20 qualifying performers: Shola Adeniran, Rashid Kabba and Aleksandra Stoilova with the latter two gaining selection. Rashid, the 5th youngest Australian male athlete in history to make the team (15 years and 6 months) and Aleks was also one of the youngest (16 years and 2 months). What an outstanding achievement from all three as they won 8 medals between them at the 2021 Australian Junior Championships.

From a club perspective it has been both inspirational and rewarding despite the difficulties of Covid-19 restrictions, and I would particularly like to thank the staff of Athletics NSW who were always ahead of the game in relation to the imposed restrictions. They were one of the few States to hold their All Schools Championships and one of the quickest to get the 2020-21 season underway. The difficulties of organising meetings with Governmental restrictions must have been incredible and yet they soldiered-on and provided a rewarding season for the athletes of NSW to perform.

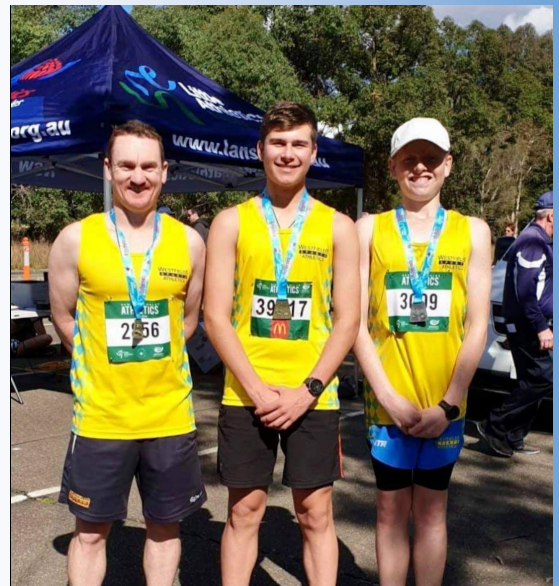


2020-21 Westfields Athletics Club Annual Presentation Night

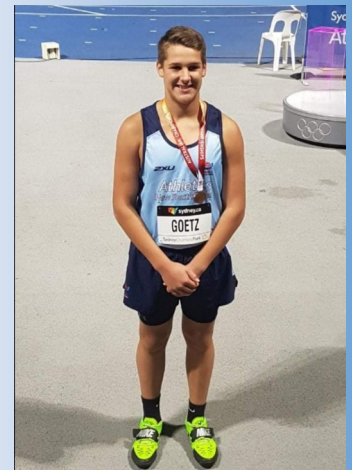

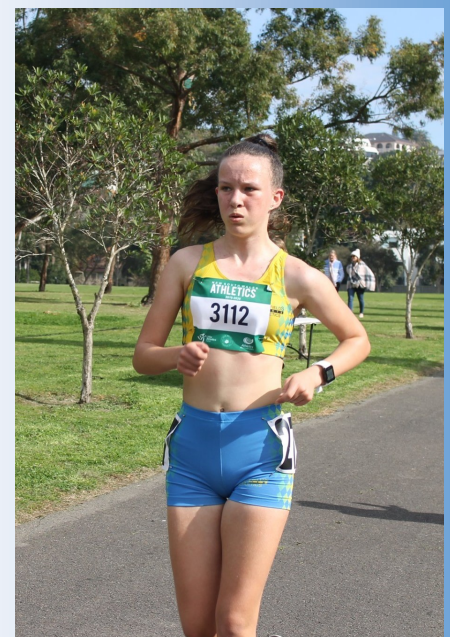
